Kitchen Volunteers Needed


Starting Sept. 13, once or twice a month (usually Wednesday evenings) we will need kitchen volunteers when food is served for church events, to help with set

Get Involved in Plans for the September 17 Kyiv Symphony Orchestra & Chorus Concert at FPC

Thank you for being part of the excitement of KickOff Sunday! Once again, the First Pres spirit of giving and caring was everywhere. This Sunday, you will again have the opportunity to sign up to get involved as we host the Kyiv Symphony Orchestra & Chorus (KSOC) Concert. A sign-up table will be provided after each worship service.

As you know, we will provide housing for the 32 KSOC musicians. We also will provide 2 meals at church, and 2 sack lunches. Multiply all these meals, prep and clean-up for 32 people, and you can appreciate the magnitude of help we are requesting!

Housing:

Sixteen total homes are needed for housing the KSOC musicians. Currently we need 6 more. Each home will provide 2 separate beds for two women. Also needed are folks to provide transportation for the musicians on Sept. 17 & 18. Sign-up sheets for housing and for transportation will be available on Sunday. Hospitality:

- 1. *Food and packaged items* are needed for musicians' meals: cases of bottled water; granola bars; cans of Coke or Pepsi; fruit salad; pies; etc. Sign-up sheets designate quantity of each being requested.
- 2. *Delivery of items*: Task Force members will be at the church from noon until 4 PM on Saturday, Sep 16 to receive donated items. Arrangements will be made if you need to deliver items at another time.
- 3. *Service Needed*: A MUST-HAVE is help for setting up, serving, and cleaning up. Times are designated on sign-up sheets for the Sunday (Sept. 17) mid-afternoon meal, a Monday (Sept. 18) evening BBQ dinner, as well Monday (Sept. 18) and Tuesday (Sept. 19) sack lunches.

We have committed to donating \$20,000 for their mission of humanitarian aid to women, orphans, war victims, and anyone in need of hope and physical comfort. As of this date, we have already raised \$6,009 for KSOC's humanitarian aid. Your gift will help us to reach our commitment of \$20,000!
