## From the Desk of Pastor Ginny

#### Dear Friends:

This is an exciting week at First Presbyterian Church! This Sunday, December 4, we will move from one blended worship at 10:00, to two separate services: at 9:00 and at 11:00. At 9:00, worship will be held in the Youth Center (on the upper level of the church but facing the Shore Drive parking lot). This service will be more or less informal; music will be provided by the Praise Band. The 11:00 service will be in the Sanctuary and will follow a more traditional format using the organ, the choir, and hymns from the hymn book.

Each of you can choose which service to attend. Your decision may be based on the time of the service, on the music you prefer, or perhaps on the people you like to be with for worship. You might even choose to attend both services to show your support of the church at this moment. You might decide to alternate services each week. If you have enjoyed worshipping in your pajamas, sipping your coffee at home, this may be the time for you to venture out and join us for in-person worship. You may feel safer than you expect. You may find friends to sit with or talk to at the end of the service. Or if you need to stay at home, or worship from elsewhere, you need to know that for the time being we will only be streaming the 11:00 service. This gives us time to assess what equipment and staffing will be needed for streaming two services each Sunday. Meanwhile the sermons will be mostly the same each week. Will there be more jokes at 9:00? Come find out!

The decision to move to two services grew out of our *The Road Ahead* conversations in September and October. As a church, you seemed ready for two services. Please pray for this important step to be well-received. Our hope is that having two services will open doors for new people to join us in worship and in mission. What a good thing! What a great moment for us all!

ADVENT: This second week of Advent, we move from the Hope candle to a focus on Peace. The main text this Sunday is Matthew's introduction to John the Baptist who prepares the way of the Lord Jesus. John's life and his preaching are not all about Peace, but we will find Peace in Christ Jesus. I'll share my thoughts on John the Baptist this week: See you on Sunday at 9:00 or at 11:00!






# Faith & Fiction Monday, Dec 5


