Years ago, I was studying in Scotland where, in December, there was a strike going on with power brown-outs and everybody frustrated. I traveled from there to Norway to be with my exchange student "sister" and her family. Norway had snow on the ground and lights sparkling in all the streets and windows. At Anette's house, there were candles everywhere. As a candle burned down it was instantly replaced with a new one. What a difference between Scotland and Norway! It was a vivid example of "light shining in the darkness." I loved Scotland and was happy to go back to resume my studies, but the bright joy of Norway really lifted my spirits.

That's the Christian faith, my friends. That's who we are at First Presbyterian Church as we follow Jesus, the child in the manger, the Savior who gave himself for us on the cross. We are reminded, even now, even in 2022, that God is in charge and that God has taken care of all of it. We can hold onto the hope and the love, the confidence and the joy that come from following a God who cares about us and about our world

# Tony's Challenge!

At the Connect Service last Sunday, Tony McCoy spoke about the biblical concept of tithing: giving back to God 10% of what we receive. Here is part of what Tony said:

Our whole life is one big blessing from God! Thankfulness fills our prayers every day! We give some of His blessings back to Him in response to all his blessings as the Bible teaches us to do. But, how about pledging to give back 10%-- a tithe? Give back to God so we at First Pres and other Christian organizations can continue His work here and now. Some of us tithe now, but more could.

What could happen if we all tithed to First Pres at 10%? According to the census, the average household income in St Pete is about \$48,000. If we all had that much and tithed, the total giving to the church would be \$888,000. That would cover all of our expenses and give us an excess!

Many of us are retired. According to the US Census, the average retirement income for a married couple in the US is about \$73,000. If we all had that much and tithed, the gift to First Pres would be \$1,300,000! And social security payments are going up by 8.7% next year!

WE KNOW THAT everyone may not be in a position to tithe, but any amount or percentage, will bring blessings, not only to the church and our mission, but even more so to each generous giver. We will be dedicating pledges in church this Sunday, December 11, at both services. Remember to bring your card, or go online to log your pledge on the church website.

We know circumstances may change. A pledge is what you hope to be able to give for the next year so the church Finance Committee can set a budget. THANK YOU!
