


If the 10:00 hour on Sundays does not fit your schedule, the service is available for viewing on our YouTube channel throughout the week. Feel free to share the link with family and friends!

The amazing collection of warm clothing, blankets, socks, and hats you have gathered to send to farmworkers at Beth-El is a vivid example of your willingness, even eagerness to share with people in need. Thank you! Thank you for your generosity! Just look at the picture below: so many items that will make February and March less cold for farmworker families in east Hillsborough County.



Now, if someone, or some team of people, would like to load these items in your truck, car, or SUV and deliver them to Beth-El, please contact the church office. Beth-El is on highway 301 in Wimauma. You could call ahead and be sure to get a tour of the Beth-El Mission, help them with food sorting, or distribution. The work our Presbyterian Mission does in the farmworker community is wonderful!

For next month's mission focus, we will be working on some needs for Lakewood Elementary School. Watch for things you can do; we'll offer a list next week!



College Scholarship Applications

We will be accepting applications for




college scholarships starting today,

through February 28th. These scholarships include the Church Family and Ohrns Scholarships for undergraduates and the Osborne Scholarship for Theology students. We only require one application is for both Fall 2022 and Spring 2023 semesters (awards are split). The applicant needs to let us know if they only need it for one semester.

For further details about these scholarships, please contact the Church Office. To apply for any of these scholarships, you will need to include: 1) a completed application form (found <u>HERE</u>); 2) a copy of your most recent high school or college transcript; 3) a 500-word essay describing your involvement in churchrelated activities as well as extra-curricular and community involvement activities, why you want this grant, and what you expect to do following the completion of your education.

The Scholarship Committee will review the applications and the Session will approve the final awards. Successful applicants will be asked to provide proof of enrollment and acceptance by their educational institution. Funds for the scholarship will be sent directly to the institution so be sure to give the proper name and address to which the funds are to be sent.
