From the Desk of Pastor Ginny

Dear Friends at FPC:

I admit to being a little jealous of those of you who are off in Virginia, Pennsylvania, West Virginia, Montana or wherever. Is it always cooler up there? Probably! I will head off to North Carolina for a short family time myself in another week or two. I can't wait!

But I also "can't wait" for our next 5th Sunday Mission Adventure. On July 31, we will be having Mission Sunday down in the Fellowship Hall, as we did in late May. There will be an upbeat worship service, then a rather challenging Mission Project for us to work on together. For this project we will assemble a very ambitious 500 personal hygiene kits (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap and soap dish, comb, and disposable razor, placed in a zip-lock bag.) These will be provided to CASA, for their residents. I am sure that our industrious assembly talents will make us hungry enough to enjoy the COVERED DISH LUNCH which will follow.

Do you know about CASA? CASA is the official provider of domestic violence support in Pinellas County. CASA Pinellas serves individuals of all genders, ages, ethnicities, abilities, and socioeconomic statuses. CASA's website says 1 in 3 women are victims of domestic violence. One in 4 men are victims of domestic violence. One in 15 children are exposed to intimate partner violence each year, and 90% of these children are eyewitnesses to this violence. Seven in 10 survivors reported that their abuser also targeted pets. On July 31, we can make a difference by showing God's love to those who have suffered abuse in their own home.

So for the Fifth Sunday of July, plan your favorite dish to share and come to worship and work together. I can hardly wait!





Whether your bereavement experience is recent or not so recent, you will find

encouragement, comfort and help in grieving the death of a spouse, child, parent, sibling, other family member, or friend. This program features biblical, Christ-centered teaching that focuses on grief topics associated with the death of a loved one. The 13-week DVD seminar features nationally respected grief experts and real-life stories of people, followed by a small group discussion about what was viewed. This is a great opportunity to be around people who understand what you are feeling. Don't allow fear of what others may think to keep you from what could help you. Confidentiality is very much a part of this program.
