In our worship service this Sunday, November 13, 2022, we will celebrate African-American music and highlight our new giving opportunity through the establishment of a special fund to benefit a person or group in the local African-American community. We will sing "Lift Every Voice and Sing" and the choir will sing gospel favorite "Total Praise." We hope that you will join us!

As we all understand, African American spirituals were often sung by slaves in the fields. Because these song originated in the enslaved community, no one ever received any royalties or acknowledgment for the composition of the songs. First Presbyterian Church has established a special fund to benefit a person or group in the local African-American community. We will lift up this voluntary giving opportunity whenever the choir or congregation sings one of the beloved African-American spirituals. When we have sufficient funds to make a gift, the Worship Committee and Session will designate the recipient. Anyone wishing to donate to this fund can make a gift, noting it for the "African-American Spiritual Fund."

Childcare/Kids Ministry Updates


- A new childcare & kid's room is **COMING ALONG!** New flooring, fresh paint, and new mini-blinds have been installed in Room 203!
